What is Project 2020?

Project 2020 is an environmental education program designed to educate children between the ages of 4-12 years old about the impacts of waste pollution. Focusing on plastics in our waterways and the importance of correct waste management and recycling, Project 2020 endeavours to inspire and empower children to be agents of change, beginning with their local environments.

Due to COVID, this is now being exclusively provided as an internally run program, which will provide schools/centres with all of the required digital content to facilitate Project 2020 independently.

There is no cost to schools/centres for registering and participating in Project 2020. It is a completely free resource available for educators to embed learning outcomes regarding environmental waste management.

PHASE 2 - DELIVERING PROJECT 2020 CONTENT

Once your school has registered for Project 2020, all digital resources will be made available for your school/centre to embed the program.

Your school/centre will be provided with all the necessary digital resources for you to run Project 2020 throughout your school/centre's education program. Project 2020 educational video series will equip children to understand the importance of environmental science, waste management and how it provides solutions for our environment. All resources will educate and support the school/centre to internally facilitate a Project 2020 waste assessment audit.

Program content includes:

PHASE 3 - COMPLETE WASTE AUDIT AND UPLOAD DATA

To successfully complete the Project 2020 program, it is a requirement to conduct and complete phase 3 of the program by COB Friday 23rd of October. This part of the program must be completed so your school/centre can be acknowledged at Phase 4 of Project 2020.

Phase 3 consists of:

- Complete internal waste audit within the school/centre grounds
- Collate waste audit data
- Film 60-90 second video of waste audit
- Upload both waste audit data and video as provided in the guide.

PHASE 4 - PROJECT 2020 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT EVENT

Schools and centres will be officially invited and acknowledged for their participation and successful completion of Project 2020, hosted by The Honourable Minister Karen Andrews. Participants will be awarded and officially acknowledged as 'Project 2020 Glowing Green Crusaders'.



This event will be held in the community to showcase the outstanding leadership of our local schools and early learning centres, who have learnt the value and importance of waste management solutions to protect our local environment.
