




PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE GOALS

Building partnerships is the foundation of the SSN vision. Supported by the 17th SDG, we are working with schools and organisations towards a sustainable future for our children. In 2021, the SSN will bring more schools and organisations together in the name of Education for Sustainability (EfS).



ATTENDEES



PROJECTED DEMOGRAPHICS

In 2019, over 600 participants from 39 schools and 44 organisations attended the in person event. Although the event in 2020 was delivered online, over 60 schools and 80 organisations participated including an estimated 1340 people.

After delivering two successful events, one in person and one online, the SSN has projected the following audience metrics for 2021.

The 2021 Sustainability Symposium is designed to engage meaningfully with students, teachers, school leaders (such as principals and business service managers), parents and caretakers (cleaners, grounds staff). The program will ensure engagement with teachers, school leaders, parents and caretakers is targeted and meaningful, thereby having a greater capacity to impact outcomes. As the overall event goal involves building partnerships it is critical to deliver a program addressing multiple school-based stakeholders.

In 2021, the SSN will invite schools from across Australia after a national audience was engaged in 2020, as we aim to engage 80 schools. Broadening the invited audience not only improves the likelihood of increased event participation, it also initiates the relationship building process between more schools, the SSN and the concept of Education for Sustainability (EfS).

Finally, organisations, councils, and government have an important role to play in EfS. Therefore, it is anticipated that the 2021 Sustainability Symposium will increase partnerships with stakeholders to 100. The total number of people aimed to be engaged through the 2021 Sustainability Symposium is 1800.



EVENT FORMAT

The 2021 Sustainability Symposium will be a hybrid event over three days from 23-25 May 2021. In 2021, the SSN intend for the week of the Symposium to be the national week of Education for Sustainability.




HOST SCHOOL

EVENT FORMAT

TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT: DAYS 1 & 2

As a cross-curriculum priority in the Australian Curriculum, sustainability is supposed to be embedded in all school subjects. This professional development opportunity for curriculum developers, teachers, teachers aides and pre-service teachers will build upon past Sustainability Symposium opportunities and deliver tangible experiences to improve capabilities to embed EfS in classrooms.

Day 1: Site visits, introductory training, networking dinner

Day 2: The SSN's Higher Education Advisory Group (academics from across Australia) will deliver high quality training in EfS.

STUDENT SESSIONS


A keynote plenary will start the day for students featuring high profile speakers to engage and inspire students to be active, responsible citizens. Workshops will follow delivering experiential learning. The day will end with a call to action.

PARENT SESSIONS

Parents are an important population within a school environment, both reinforcing lessons from school and also potential human resources for the busy educational context. Parents will have an opportunity to learn from numerous presenters throughout the day (shorter day to allow for pick up and drop off).

CARETAKER SESSIONS

Presentations throughout the day aim to engage Caretakers in EfS. Delivering hands on learning experiences and networking opportunities these sessions will offer professional development to an often undervalued population within the school environment.





EVENT FORMAT

SCHOOL LEADER SESSIONS

Connecting school communities with sustainable resource management exemplars and a network of peers is an important aspect of the 2021 Sustainability Symposium. Business managers and principals are invited to keynote presentations, an interactive workshop and a panel discussion involving leading colleagues. This exciting program will be delivered on the 3rd day of the event to ensure a wholistic approach to EfS is possible.

CONNECT-ED

Many businesses have indicated this event is an excellent opportunity to showcase their building management resources, curriculum tools and/or sustainably sourced products. Connecting school communities with community resources is an important aspect of the 2021 Sustainability Symposium. Event delegates will be invited to visit the displays of local businesses and community organisations. Further an 'Imagine Zone' will provide a space to creatively collaborate on envisioning a sustainable future.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DINNER

Providing opportunities for networking and professional development, the 2021 Sustainability Symposium dinner will be held at ASAS on the 25th of May 2021.

Mudjira Village Eatery will again deliver a sustainably-sourced meal that is delicious and a statement of what's possible when delivering a sustainable event.

The panel discussion regarding *reimagining education* will feature as the key entertainment for the evening, along with the sweet sounds of the ASAS orchestra.




